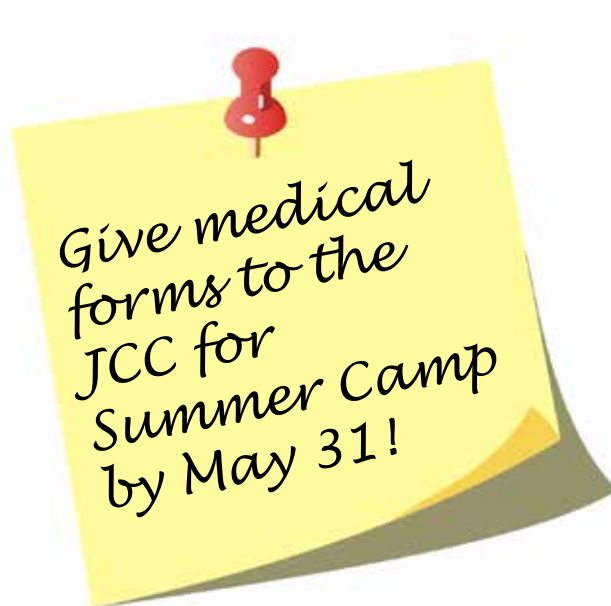

WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY - I wish to participate and/or give my children permission to participate in the Worcester Jewish Community Center (JCC) activities. I understand that even when every reasonable precaution is taken, accidents can sometimes happen. In exchange for the JCC allowing me to participate in JCC activities, I understand and expressly acknowledge that I release the JCC and its staff members from all liability for any injury, loss, or damage connected in any way whatsoever to my (or my children's) participation in JCC activities, whether on or off JCC's premises. I authorize JCC staff to act in their best judgment in the event of an emergency; including transporting me or my child(ren) to the hospital and authorizing treatment by a physician. I understand that this release includes any claims based on the negligence, action, or inaction of the JCC, its employees, independent contractors, directors, members and guests. I have read and am voluntarily signing this authorization and release. I understand that the JCC is not responsible for personal property lost, damaged, or stolen while members and/or program participants are using JCC facilities or are on JCC premises, including all lost, damaged or stolen property caused by the negligence of the JCC, its employees, independent contractors, directors, members and guests. I understand the JCC does not offer medical insurance relating to all accidents and/or injuries that may result from my or my family's participation in JCC activities. I will be responsible for maintaining any appropriate medical insurance for myself or my children.

A payment of \$75 per week/per child is required. Deposits are non-refundable and cannot be applied to other JCC programs/fees. Payment for all camp fees are due in full by 5/11/2018. After 5/11 payment in full is due at the time of registration. Prior to 5/11 any drops of camp weeks will be refunded minus the \$75/per child/per week non-refundable deposit. After 5/11 camp fees are non-refundable. All changes made after 5/11 will incur a \$25/per change/per child/per week change fee. Total camp charges subject to verification.

MEDICAL FORMS DUE MAY 31 (PLEASE READ):

State guidelines require that all campers have a medical examination before the start of camp. Please note that lead paint tests are required. No child will be admitted to camp without a completed medical form. *FORMS DUE BY MAY 31*. Registrations completed after May 31 require medical forms at the time of registration.

FEES: All fees for all summer programs must be paid in full by Friday, May 11 unless special arrangements have been made. The JCC cannot guarantee placement if balances are outstanding after this date.

FORMS: Please complete and return all forms at time of registration.

MORNING DROP OFF: Each program group will be assigned to a classroom. Please bring your child to his/her classroom at 9:00 AM.

PICK-UP: All children should be picked up in his/her classroom. For someone other than a parent to pick-up, prior written permission from you and proper identification must be shown.

Children enrolled in Extended Day Module 7:30 to 9:00 AM will be dropped off in a designated classroom. Children enrolled in Extended Day Module 4:00 to 5:30 PM will be picked up in a designated classroom or at the playground (depending on the weather).

Please be prompt --- A late fee of \$5 for every five minute period will be charged. Please be considerate of your child and the staff. We appreciate your cooperation and would like to extend our gratitude in advance.

TRANSPORTATION: Participants requesting transportation will be informed of details one week prior to the start of programs.

SIGN UP FOR J ALERT, THE NEW JCC TEXT MESSAGE ALERT SYSTEM

JCC members and participants sign up to receive JCC text messages via their cell phones. The JCC will use the J Alert system to communicate critical opening/closing time changes and other important information. Participants choose one or more categories of alerts: general building information (includes weather-related opening/closing time changes, safety messages), group exercise classes, pool and spa. We will not use J Alert for general communication, payment requests, or social and non-critical messages.

Please note that even with J Alert, the JCC will continue to communicate closing and safety information via email and other means. Visit our website to sign up for J Alert.

MEDICATION:

Written permission from physician giving summer program staff permission to administer medication is required. Permission slips can be obtained from a preschool director.

If a child needs medication during the program day:

All prescription medicine must be brought in the original container.

All over-the-counter medication must be accompanied by a written consent by the doctor.

CLOTHING:

All participants should wear clothes that are comfortable and washable. It is recommended that participants wear sneakers or other closed and securely fastened shoes. Sandals inhibit activity and may be dangerous.

DAILY ESSENTIAL LIST:

1. 3's and 4's.....1 swimsuit & 1 towel
4's.....remaining until 4:00 PM will have a rest time or planned activity
5's.....remaining until 1:30 PM – 1 swimsuit & 1 one towel
5's.....remaining until 4:00 PM – 2 swimsuits & 2 towels
2. Plastic bag or waterproof tote bag for wet swimsuits.
3. Suntan lotion, insect repellent (labeled with name) – These items must be supplied by parent if desired. Please apply suntan lotion prior to start of program day. We will reapply after swim.
4. Hat for sunny days.
5. Program T-Shirt on Friday (please) for Shabbat.
6. 3's and 4's – a change of clothing to be kept at Preschool.

PLEASE!! – **CLEARLY LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.** We cannot guarantee return of lost items that are unlabeled.

FOOD:

4 & 5 year old participants should bring lunch and beverage every day except Friday which is cookout day.

Several children in our program have a severe allergy to peanuts; therefore, Preschool is peanut free. Strict avoidance is the only way to prevent an allergic reaction. The allergy can be life threatening and as a result we have decided to institute a peanut free center. Please read the labels on food when preparing children's lunches to be certain that products containing peanuts and tree nuts are not brought into the center. Thank you in advance for your help with this important safety precaution.

If a parent wishes to bring a cake to the group for a child's birthday, it must be an Entenmann's product, Friendly, Carvel, or a product from the European Bakery.

PLEASE pack your child's lunch in a clearly labeled lunch box.

All lunches will be refrigerated. Preschool will provide a morning and an afternoon snack. Please note that all food served at the JCC is kosher.

SHABBAT:

Shabbat is celebrated every Friday. Challahs will be provided by Preschool. In celebration of Shabbat, we ask that participants wear their Program T-Shirts on Friday.

AQUATICS Parent Information:

1. We utilize both pools for instructional and free swim. Children are in both pools during the course of their program experience.
2. We recommend plastics bags to keep wet bathing suits and towels in.
3. Swimmers with shoulder length hair must tie their hair back, or wear a bathing cap.
4. Teaching staff consists of all Red Cross Certified Water Safety Instructors.
5. Counselors assist the swim teachers during instructional swim. Counselors also help to supervise the swimmers during free swim.
6. Children are grouped by ability according to Red Cross swim levels.
7. During extreme weather, children will not be swimming outdoors.
8. Swimmers may wear swim goggles for instructional and free swim.
9. There will be Red Cross Certified Lifeguards at both pools during instructional swim.
10. PER ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT: Swimmers may not enter the water if they have an open wound, or a communicable disease.
11. If a participant is well enough to attend the program, they participate in the swim program.

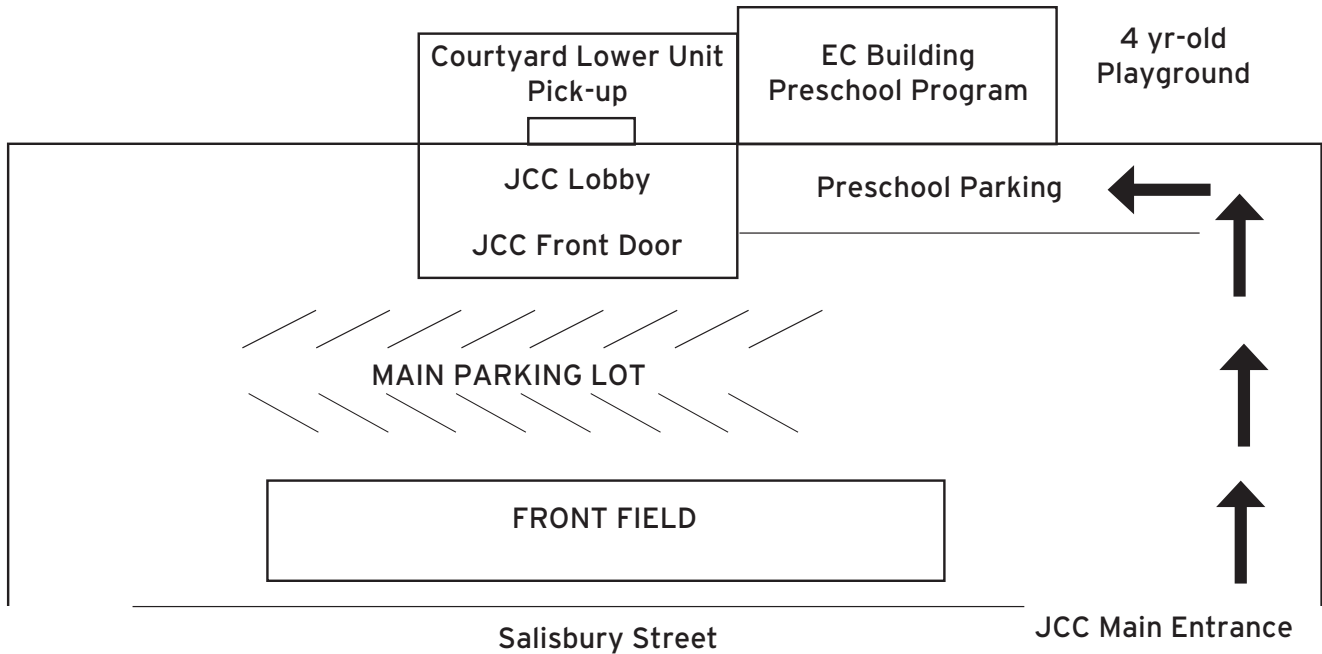

Preschool and Sports Drop-Off & Pick Up Procedures

PRESCHOOL has its own parking lot for drop-off and pick-up. Preschool parents can park in the upper parking lot or in the main parking lot.



SPORTS CAMP drop-off...will enter the main driveway and continue along with the traffic flow. Drop-off camper at the JCC main entrance. Pick-up camper on the front field. Parents can park in the main parking lot or the spaces on the side of the front field. Please look for your child's counselors to sign out. There will be sports camp staff outside to direct traffic to the drop-off and pick-up area.
