Facilities...Fully equipped gymnasium, indoor and outdoor pools, tennis courts, basketball courts, two athletic fields, outdoor climbing tower, an adventure playground, air-conditioned Early Childhood Center, auditorium and stage, wooded campsites and pond.

Health & Safety..."On Call" doctor is available during camp hours. Medical forms are required from all campers prior to the start of camp.

Membership...JCC membership is not required to enroll in camp; non-member fees apply.

The following are required for all children before they start camp:

- ◆ completed health form
- ◆ any relevant information pertaining to your child
- ◆ full payment due by...Friday, May 21

AFTER MAY 21, payment in full at time of registration.

Payment of Fees and Deposits / Refund Policy

- **A NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT OF \$75 PER WEEK** of camp is required and must accompany each camp application. No refunds or pro rata adjustments for missed days, including illness, family situations and vacations. Forfeited deposits/fees may not be applied to other programs/fees.
- Payment for all camp fees are due in full by Friday, May 21, 2010. After May 21, payment in full is due at time of registration. Children will not be permitted to attend camp if fees are not paid in full. No refunds of any fees after Friday, May 21, 2010.
- All changes after Friday, May 21, 2010, will incur a \$25 change fee per child. If requested changes are not available, there will be no refunds after Friday, May 21, 2010.
- To receive member rates, your account must be current (no past due amounts) and your membership must be in effect through August 31, 2010.

Scholarships... A limited number of need based scholarships are available. Interviews required for 1st time applicants. Early application for scholarship is strongly encouraged as funds are quickly depleted! Camp registration must be submitted with a refundable deposit of \$25 per week per child along with the financial aid application. If the deposit is a hardship registration, the registration will be put on hold until the application can be reviewed. To be considered in the first round, all paperwork and required interviews must be completed by Friday, May 7, 2010. First round applicants will be notified by Friday, May 28, 2010 and must respond by Friday, June 4, 2010 to indicate whether or not the child will be attending or the camp space may be forfeited. Requests, after the first round, will be considered if funds are still available. Additional financial assistance will be processed as received until scholarship funds are depleted.

Camp Transportation...Transportation from the Westboro and Shrewsbury service areas are available at the rate of \$12/per day round trip or \$7/each way. No refunds for transportation services.

Medical Examinations...Medical forms are required for camp entry by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. No child will be admitted to a JCC camp without signed and completed medical forms and all fees will be forfeited. Medical forms must be returned by Friday, May 21, 2010.
